Why plan it as early as possible?

The earlier the student joins, the more comfortable and economical the academic distribution. Starting in 3rd ESO with 5 hours a week is not the same as trying to close everything in 2nd Bachillerato with 10–12 hours a week.

What exactly is the Dual Diploma?

It is not an English course. It is a dual-qualification program that leads the student to earn the U.S. High School Diploma alongside their Spanish education path.

How it works

- ✓ The student continues at their school or local path without interruption.
- ✓ Chanak evaluates their complete academic record.
- ✓ A personalized path of the required credits is defined.
- ✓ Up to 75% of the record may be recognized, subject to evaluation.
- ✓ The student completes the remaining Core USA credits with Chanak.
- ✓ Material is worked through self-study physical modules and Life Skills in the LMS.
- ✓ On completing the requirements, Chanak issues the official diploma.

What it is NOT

- ✗ It is not homeschooling or leaving the Spanish system.
- ✗ It does not require moving to or studying in the U.S.
- ✗ It is not a basic English program.
- ✗ It does not replace ESO or Bachillerato.
- ✗ It should not be confused with Chanak's Off-Campus program.
- ✗ There are no automatic credits without prior evaluation.

About the 75% recognition

It is not automatic. It depends on the academic history, the subjects taken and the entry level. It is confirmed in the diagnostic assessment.

* Transferable credits are recorded in accordance with the school's official transcript of grades and are updated annually. These credits correspond to the Chanak component of the Dual Diploma and are registered in the SIS according to diagnostic assessment, progress and academic evidence.

What does Chanak Academy offer?

The program is not just a diploma. It is a complete system of academic, technological and guidance support for the student and their family.

01 · Diagnostic assessment

Record analysis: entry level, recognizable credits and personalized path. Mandatory first step.

02 · Personalized Route Plan

Which credits to complete, in how much time and with what estimated weekly workload.

03 · SIS access

Management portal: progress, credits, grades, reports, payments and communication with the family.

04 · Organized LMS

Resources, activities, evidence and materials organized by course and level.

05 · Academic supervision

The team monitors progress, detects delays and adjusts the path when necessary.

06 · Weekly mentoring

Follow-up sessions with the academic tutor: objectives, questions and pace.

07 · Official American transcript

Official document in U.S. format with credits, grades and institutional seal.

08 · University guidance

Support to build the university portfolio and prepare the application from Grade 10.

09 · Core USA support

Direct support in the Core subjects: content, methodology and assessments.

10 · Diploma issuance

On completing the 24+ required credits, Chanak issues the High School Diploma as an institution registered in Florida.

LMS and SIS platforms

Note on 1st and 2nd ESO: these are preparatory leveling stages. The student may advance subjects according to the diagnostic assessment; the price is set through a personalized plan.

The sooner, the better: the earlier the student starts, the lower the average annual cost and the more comfortable the academic distribution.

How do you start?

A clear, supported and pressure-free process: five steps from first contact to the start of the program.

1 · Information request

The family gets in touch through the website or by email. A free orientation meeting is scheduled to present the program and understand the student's situation.

2 · Assessment payment

The family makes the initial payment before the diagnostic.

3 · Diagnostic assessment

The team analyzes the record, English level and current situation.

4 · Route Plan + enrollment

The path is presented and the family formalizes enrollment.
Payment activates access to the LMS and the SIS. No hidden charges.

5 · Program start

Full LMS access, active SIS profile and the academic path underway. The family stays connected to the system from day one.

Required documents

- ✓ Student identity document (national ID / passport)
- ✓ Latest grades or school report (last 2 years)
- ✓ Academic history or certificate of studies
- ✓ Legal guardian details (father, mother or guardian)
- ✓ Letter of intent (provided by Chanak)
- ✓ Student profile photo in digital format



What families usually ask

Does the Dual Diploma affect the Spanish selectividad?

No. It is a complementary and parallel program. It does not interfere with Bachillerato or with the EBAU/EVAU. The student continues their Spanish path as normal.

How many hours per week does the student need?

It depends on the entry level: between 3–4 hours in leveling (1st–2nd ESO) and up to 10–12 hours in 2nd Bachillerato. The Route Plan specifies the exact workload.

Is the diploma valid for U.S. universities?

Chanak is registered in Florida (FLDOE #134620) and is an Official Candidate for MSA-CESS Accreditation. The diploma may form part of the documentation submitted for admission; recognition varies by university and country.

Is the 75% recognition automatic?

No. The percentage is determined case by case in the diagnostic assessment, according to academic history, subjects taken, English level and year of entry.

Can it start during ESO?

Yes, and it is the most advisable option. Joining in 3rd or 4th ESO allows a better distribution of the weekly workload and reduces the annual cost. 1st and 2nd ESO have a leveling stage with personalized pricing.

And if the student joins late, in Bachillerato?

It is possible, but the weekly workload increases considerably (8–12 h). The team assesses feasibility and designs an adapted plan. Starting as early as possible is recommended.
